6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 18.2-32.3, relating to human
7	infant; independent and separate existence.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-32.3 as follows:
10	§ 18.2-32.3. Human infant; independent and separate existence.
11	For the purposes of this article, the fact that the umbilical cord has not been cut or that the placenta
12	remains attached shall not be considered in determining whether a human infant has achieved an
13	independent and separate existence.
14	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
15	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is
16	for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter 781
17	of the Acts of Assembly of 2009 requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a
18	minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary
19	appropriation is for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile
20	Justice.
