7 to the Commonwealth and to veterans with disabilities and their families; and

8 WHEREAS, therapeutic riding has been identified to be successful in treating children and adults 9 with physical and mental disabilities; and

10 WHEREAS, the Lonesome Dove Equestrian Center, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, was 11 established to provide recreational therapeutic riding for veterans with disabilities as part of an effective 12 and efficient community-based rehabilitation system; and

 veterans with disabilities, enabling them to integrate successfully back into their community after injury;

WHEREAS, the Lonesome Dove Equestrian Center has served over 250 disabled veterans to dateand now has the ability to serve an average of 200 veterans with disabilities per year; and

18 WHEREAS, the Lonesome Dove Equestrian Center has helped other communities across the19 Commonwealth set up their own programs to serve veterans with disabilities and their families; and

WHEREAS, the Lonesome Dove Equestrian Center provides community awareness semiannually
 through fundraiser trail rides, horseshoe tournaments, and slideshow presentations to community
 organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Lonesome Dove Equestrian Center and its hardworking board of directors, staff,
 volunteers, and generous supporters make possible the services needed to help veterans with disabilities
 meet their daily challenges and lead a life of their choice; now, therefore, be it
