6	WHEREAS, Dr. Patricia Picard Cormier has served honorably as the 24th president of Longwood
7	University from 1996 to 2010; and
8	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's exemplary leadership transformed the institution from college to university
9	status; and
10	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's strengthening of the academic program led to many developments,
11	including the creation of the Cormier Honors College for Citizen Scholars, mandatory internships for all
12	
	graduates, the laptop initiative, the faculty connections program, and a new undergraduate nursing
13 14	program; and WHEREAS Dr. Cormier's embrace of the poble concent of civitas has been embedded in
14	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's embrace of the noble concept of <i>civitas</i> has been embodied in Longwood's concept of the citizen scholar/leader; and

17	WHEREAS, under Dr. Cormier's tenure, Longwood University has achieved consistently noteworthy academic rankings as designated by U.S. News & World Report; and
18	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's leadership effected the development of a comprehensive long-range

19 20	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's ability to endear alumni and patrons to Longwood University resulted in
20 21	the largest gift ever from a living donor, the first capital campaign ever conducted by Longwood
22	University, and the tripling of the endowment fund; and
$\frac{22}{23}$	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's appreciation of aesthetic values resulted in the enhanced beautification of
24	the campus and the incorporation of the arts into the everyday lives of the students; and
25	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's crisis management skills at the time of the Ruffner fire unified the
26	Longwood family and afterwards her efforts succeeded in the historically accurate reconstruction of the
27	signature buildings dear to the campus community; and
28	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's understanding of the value of the physical campus to the academic
29	program led to the construction of the Chichester Science Center, the Center for Communication Studies
30	and Theatre, the Bedford Hall addition, and the Student Health and Wellness Center; and
31	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's vision for Longwood University resulted in NCAA Division I
32	classification for the athletic program; and
33	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's endorsement of sustainability has been embraced across the campus in
34	building design and daily life practices, leading to recognition of Longwood University's achievement in
35	this arena by outside agencies; and
36	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's knowledge of the practicality of public/private partnerships and the
37	evolution of student lifestyles has led to the creation of three off-campus residential villages, all
38	networked into the central campus life; and
39	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's national professional role has taken Longwood University's name across
40	the country through her leadership in numerous organizations and activities such as the American
41	Association of State Colleges and Universities, the American Council on Education Fellows, and LEAD
42	Virginia; and
43	WHEREAS, Dr. Cormier's dedication and devotion to higher education exemplify to the very fullest
44 45	the embodiment of the citizen leader; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the Senate the House of Delegates concurring. That the General Assembly
45 46	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly commend Patricia Picard Cormier for her 14 years of outstanding leadership as the president of
40 47	Longwood University and her lifelong career as an educator and higher education administrator whose
