- 6 WHEREAS, Vincent A. Tassa, Jr., was born on March 11, 1943, in Washington, D.C., and attended 7 Chamberlain High School; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Vincent A. Tassa married Marie Agnes Clarke on October 19, 1963, and the couple have five children, Daniel Gabriel Tassa, Vincent Amato Tassa III, Anthony Michael Tassa, Teresa 9 10 Marie Gardiner, and Gina Marie Piccoli; and
- WHEREAS, on March 11, 1964, Vincent Tassa joined the Washington, D.C., Metropolitan Police 11 12 Department; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Vincent Tassa attended the University of Maryland, where he studied criminal justice; during his career, he graduated from the Northern Virginia Criminal Justice Training Academy, 14 15 Metropolitan Police Academy, White House and United States Park Police Academy, Bureau of 16 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs training program, and other criminal justice academies; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Vincent Tassa was seriously injured in 1966 in the line of duty and retired from the Washington Metropolitan Police Department in January 1967; and 18
- 19 WHEREAS, in 1968 Vincent Tassa joined the Prince William County Sheriff's Office and attended 20 Criminal Justice Courtroom Security training; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Vincent Tassa was appointed justice of the peace by the Honorable Arthur Sinclair, a 22 Prince William County Circuit Court judge, in July 1970; and
- WHEREAS, Vincent Tassa was appointed magistrate for the 31st Judicial District by the Honorable 23 24 H. Selwyn Smith of the Prince William County Circuit Court in 1985; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Vincent Tassa attended the Supreme Court Certification Academy for Magistrates in Virginia in 1985 and continued his legal education with the Virginia Supreme Court; and 26
- 27 WHEREAS, Vincent Tassa is a marriage celebrant and has performed more than 1,000 wedding 28 ceremonies: and
- 29 WHEREAS, Vincent Tassa has given generously of his time and talents throughout the years; he has 30 prepared spaghetti dinners, sang, and played music for churches, Lions Clubs, Masonic Lodges, Knights of Columbus, Prince William Hospital, Caton Merchant House, district homes, children's homes, cystic 31 32 fibrosis events, weddings, political functions, school booster clubs, drama clubs, funerals, and many 33 more charitable and personal events; and
- 34 WHEREAS, Vincent Tassa retired from the Virginia Magistrate System on January 1, 2010; now, 35 therefore, be it 36 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly 37 commend and congratulate Vincent A.
