### SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 186

WHEREAS, Lee Bell of Fauquier County is recognized in 2010 for his service to his community and his fellow citizens; and

WHEREAS, Lee Bell was born on May 10, 1941, in Leesburg, attended Marshall High School, and received a bachelor's degree from Bridgewater College and a master's degree from the University of Virginia; and

WHEREAS, Lee Bell and his wife, Effie Fries Bell, were married on August 18, 1963, in Manassas, and the couple are the parents of two children and the grandparents of four children; and

WHEREAS, before becoming a principal in Fauquier County, Lee Bell taught science for one year in Rockingham County and four years at Warrenton Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, an exemplary administrator, Lee Bell was principal at Rhodes Elementary School in Front Royal; and

WHEREAS, a positive role model and mentor for young people, Lee Bell has been a principal in Fauquier County for 41 years at P.B. Smith Elementary School and C. Hunter Ritchie Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, an outstanding educator in Virginia for 47 years, Lee Bell demonstrated great concern for all the children he came in contact with on a daily basis; now, therefore, be it
