WHEREAS, Carolyn Moses Lusardi, a leading citizen of Brookneal, died on May 9, 2009; and

6 7 WHEREAS, a graduate of Appomattox County High School, Carolyn Lusardi received a bachelor's degree in library science from The College of William and Mary; and 8

WHEREAS, Carolyn Lusardi married the love of her life, Vincent Lusardi, Sr., and together they 9 raised their six children, Jean, Mary, Virginia, Vincent Joseph Lusardi, Jr., Joseph, and John; and 10

WHEREAS, Carolyn Lusardi was a well-known figure to local young people as librarian at William 11 12 Campbell High School; and

WHEREAS, a longtime resident of Brookneal, Carolyn Lusardi desired to serve her community and 13 14 fellow citizens; she did so as mayor and town council member and also served on the Brookneal and 15 Campbell County Bicentennial Commissions; and

WHEREAS, Carolyn Lusardi's contributions at Red Hill were legendary and she was a member, past 16 president, and past president emeritus of the board of trustees of the Patrick Henry Memorial 17 Foundation; she also helped filmmakers produce an A&E documentary on the life of Patrick Henry in 18 19 1995; and

20 WHEREAS, Carolyn Lusardi served on the Virginia Independence Bicentennial Commission (1965-1983) and on the State Commission that established the Virginia Community College System; and 21 22 WHEREAS, Carolyn Lusardi also generously gave of her time and talents as an advisory board

member of the Patrick Henry Boys & Girls Home and as a member of the Staunton River and Campbell 23 24 County Historical Societies, Brookneal Woman's Club, and Brookneal United Methodist Church; and

25 WHEREAS, Carolyn Lusardi also served as the organizing regent of the Red Hill Chapter of the 26 Daughters of the American Revolution and as District III secretary as well as past president of the Red 27 Hill Garden Club; and

28 WHEREAS, Carolyn Lusardi received many awards and accolades for her involvement in the 29 community, including the Community Builders Award by the Staunton River Masonic Lodge No. 155, 30 Chamber of Commerce Outstanding Community Service Award, and The College of William and Mary 31 Public Service in Virginia Award; she was named Citizen of the Year by the Brookneal Lions Club; and

WHEREAS, Carolyn Lusardi leaves behind a rich legacy of love for her family and service to the 32 33 community and Commonwealth; and

34 WHEREAS, Carolyn Lusardi will be greatly missed by her surviving children, Jean Carolyn Lusardi, 35 Mary Teresa Colbert, Virginia Godwin Cox, and Vincent Joseph Lusardi, Jr., and their families; her 36 numerous other family members and friends; and the Town of Brookneal; now, therefore, be it

37 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly note with 38 great sadness the loss of Carolyn Moses Lusardi; and, be it
