4. Title: **Freedom of Information Act; Recording of public meetings.**

5. Summary: The bill clarifies that no public body may prohibit or prevent any person from photographing, filming, recording, or otherwise reproducing any portion of a meeting required to be open. The bill also prohibits any public body from conducting an open meeting in any building or facility where any recording devices are prohibited.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: FINAL.

8. Fiscal Implications: The impacts are indeterminate as there may be costs incurred in finding new meeting locations for any state entities that currently hold open meetings in buildings or facilities where recording devices are prohibited.
