**4. Title:** Elections; filing deadlines

**5. Summary:** Increases the duration of time between filing deadlines and November elections. Declarations of candidacy for a special election held in November will need to be filed 81 days, rather than 74 days, before the election. A referendum election must be ordered 81 days, rather than 60 days, before the referendum election.

**6. Fiscal impact is minimal.**

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This legislation may increase administrative burden to the State Board of Elections and local governments to prepare ballots in a shorter time period during presidential election years.
