4. Title: Elections; increases duration of time between filing deadlines and November elections.

5. Summary: Increases the duration of time between filing deadlines and November elections. Declarations of candidacy for a special election held in November will need to be filed 81 days, rather than 74 days, before the election. A referendum election must be ordered 81 days, rather than 60 days, before the referendum election.

6. Fiscal Impact is Minimal.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation may increase administrative burden to the State Board of Elections and local governments to prepare ballots in a shorter time period during presidential election years.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: State Board of Elections, local government
