4. Title: Surplus property; proceeds from sale or lease of State Police communication towers or sites.

5. Summary: Provides that the proceeds from sales or leases of any interest in State Police communication towers or sites, above the costs of the transaction, shall be deposited in a special account of the Department of State Police to be used to acquire, construct, maintain, repair or replace communication towers or sites.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: Yes, Revenue - Page 1; Item 407 (nongeneral fund)

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of State Police, the proposal would reduce revenue to the general fund by about \$94,188 per year but increase nongeneral fund support for the State Police. The agency would use these funds to acquire, construct, maintain, repair or replace communication towers or sites.
