4. Title: Juvenile records; gang information; exceptions to confidentiality.

5. Summary: Places an affirmative duty on the Department of Juvenile Justice to provide information to law-enforcement that may aid in initiating or furthering an investigation of a criminal street gang. The legislation also requires that the Department or locally operated court services unit to release law enforcement information on a juvenile's criminal street gang involvement and the criminal street gang-related activity of others and to include the identity of or identifying information of the juvenile. Locally designated gang coordinators and task forces are added as authorized recipients of such information.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ), the proposal should have no fiscal impact on the agency.
