- **5. Summary:** Increases the requirement for state-supported instructional positions for students identified as having limited English proficiency from 17 full-time equivalent positions for each 1,000 students to 30 full-time equivalent positions for each 1,000 students.

Fiscal Implications:** This legislation modifies the funding for Limited English Proficiency (LEP) instruction by changing the staffing ratio from 17 full-time equivalent instructional positions per 1,000 LEP students to 30 positions per 1,000 LEP students. Based on the Governor's introduced budget, the Department of Education estimates the state share of the cost to increase the ratio will be \$28.0 million in FY 2011 and \$31.4 million in FY 2012.
