4. Title: Brown v. Board of Education Scholarship Program

5. Summary: Expands the eligibility for scholarships awarded through the Brown v. Board of Education Scholarship Program to include the cost of professional degree programs and mandatory fees. This legislation also provides a book allowance for each student. Additionally, the bill also clarifies that awards may be granted for part-time or full-time attendance in approved education programs.
