4. Title: **Campaign Finance Disclosure Act; materials provided by State Board of Elections & Attorney General.**

5. Summary: Requires the Attorney General to provide a written explanation of the provisions of the Campaign Finance Disclosure Act that prohibit the personal use of campaign funds and to delineate the differences between prohibited personal uses of campaign funds and permitted uses of the funds. The Attorney General's explanation shall be distributed by the State Board to all candidates, committees, and persons subject to the act's provisions.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: There is minimal fiscal impact incurred by the distribution of the Attorney General's explanation in addition to other materials already provided by the State Board of Elections. There may be minimal fiscal impact incurred by the Attorney General.
