3. Committee: General Laws

4. Title: **Uniform Statewide Building Code; buildings or structures built on state-owned property.**

5. Summary: Provides that the Uniform Statewide Building Code shall also apply to buildings or structures built on state-owned property. The bill requires the Department of General Services to act as the building official for all buildings or structures built on state-owned property. The bill contains technical amendments.

The substitute bill includes additional exemptions, resulting in no change to the fiscal impact.

6. Minimal fiscal impact.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: Expanding enforcement of Building Code compliance to structures on state-owned property will minimally impact the workload for the Department of General Services. The agency anticipates review of a few (or none) additional properties annually.
