**3. Committee:** Passed both houses.

**4. Title:** **Fishing license, special; Department of Game and Inland Fisheries to issue free licenses to disabled, active duty military personnel.**

**5. Summary:** This bill authorizes the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (DGIF) to issue free fishing licenses to disabled, active duty military personnel who are receiving inpatient or outpatient medical treatment from a veterans or military hospital in Virginia, an adjoining state, or the District of Columbia. There is no cost for the license, and it is valid for one year.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final. No fiscal impact.

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** For any license issued under the bill, DGIF would forgo any revenue it might have received from the sale of a license without this exemption. It is anticipated that any fiscal impact will be insignificant and the agency will absorb any costs.
