5. Summary: This bill allows wastewater treatment facilities on the Eastern Shore to acquire nitrogen and phosphorus credits from facilities in the Potomac and Rappahannock tributaries. Currently, a permitted facility can acquire point source nitrogen credits, among other restrictions, from one or more permitted facilities in the same tributary.
