- **8. Fiscal Implications:** Chapter 891, 2007 Acts of Assembly, establishes the Aerospace Advisory Council as an advisory council within the executive branch of state government. The council is comprised of 14 members: four legislative members and 10 nonlegislative citizen members. According to Chapter 891, compensation and expenses of legislative members are paid from the budgets of the Clerk of the House of Delegates and the Clerk of the Senate. Expenses of the nonlegislative members and other expenses of the council are paid from the budget of the Office of the Secretary of Technology; nonlegislative members serve without compensation. The Office of the Secretary of Technology also serves as staff to the council.

No additional funding was provided to the Office of the Secretary of Technology or the General Assembly upon enactment of the legislation by the 2007 General Assembly, so the affected agencies have absorbed any costs associated with the council.

11. Other Comments: SB23 also removes the July 1, 2010, sunset date for the council.
