2. Patron: Miller, P.J.

3. Committee: Militia, Police and Public Safety

4. Title: State Police; gang membership reporting.

5. Summary: Requires the Department of Juvenile Justice to enter the person's name and other appropriate gang-related information required by the Department of State Police into the information system known as the Organized Criminal Gang File of the Virginia Criminal Information Network when the Department of Juvenile Justice determines that the person is a member of a gang.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary; See Item 8 below.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The provisions of this bill require that anytime a resident (juvenile) self-reports, associates with a gang, or is arrested with a known gang member, agency staff would be required to enter gang information into VCIN in accordance with the requirements of the Department of State Police. If the data is entered at a central location, the Department of Juvenile Justice would need an Office Services Specialist position. The expected cost of this position is \$33,750 per year.

According to the Department of State Police, there are no expected costs to them due to this proposal.
