3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Mobile dental clinics; Board of Dentistry to develop regulations

5. Summary: Requires the Board of Dentistry to develop regulations for the registration of mobile dental clinics and other portable dental operations. Moreover, the bill would prohibit any person from operating any such operation without first registering it with the board. In addition, mobile dental clinics or other portable dental operations operated by federal, state, or local government agencies or other entities identified by the board in regulations would be exempt from the registration requirement.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation would add language to the Code of Virginia to allow for the regulation of mobile dental clinics. The language contained in the bill is similar to Appropriation Act language currently set-out in Chapter 781, 2009 Virginia Acts of Assembly. Therefore, no fiscal impact is anticipated.
