4. Title: Abortion; informed consent

5. Summary: Requires information on the effects abortion may have on future pregnancies to be included in the information required for informed consent.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: None.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: Any physician, who fails to provide the information on the effects on future pregnancies required for informed consent, may be subject to a civil penalty of \$2,500. This civil penalty is currently applied to any physician who fails to comply with any of the provisions included in Section 18.2-76.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Department of Health and courts

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: The bill was amended to require information published or reviewed in peer-reviewed medical journals regarding effects abortion may have on future pregnancies to be included in the information required for informed consent.
