3. Committee: Militia, Police and Public Safety

4. Title: Jail farms; transportation of prisoners.

5. Summary: Allows for a regional jail operated within Planning District Five (Roanoke Valley-Alleghany) to transport prisoners, upon their release, back to the locality where arrested or convicted.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Compensation Board, the proposed legislation would not have a fiscal impact on the agency since the Board does not reimburse for transporting inmates. This bill is for the Western Virginia Regional Jail to assist the participant sheriffs' offices with transporting inmates back to their original jurisdictions upon release, because the jail has an agreement with their community to not directly release the inmates on site.
