4. Title: **Government Data Collection and Dissemination Practices Act; Collection of social security numbers.**

5. Summary: The engrossed bill sets out the original date, January 1, 1975, when social security numbers were authorized to be collected and required by state and local agencies under federal law. It also clarifies that nothing in the bill should be construed to prohibit the collection of a social security number for sole the purpose of complying with the Virginia Debt Collection Act or the Setoff Debt Collection Act.
