**4. Title:**         **Board of Game and Inland Fisheries; regulatory authority.**

**5. Summary:** This bill expands the authority of the Board of Game and Inland Fisheries to adopt regulations on the feeding of game, game animals, or fur-bearing animals or feeding of wildlife that results in property damage or public health or safety concerns. Currently, the Board has the authority to adopt regulations pertaining to the hunting, taking, capture, killing, possession, sale, purchase, and transportation of any wild bird, wild animal, or inland water fish.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Game and Inland Fisheries will absorb any minimal costs associated with the additional regulation.
