2. Patron: Lingamfelter

3. Committee: Passed both houses.

4. Title: **Model bow hunting ordinance; penalty.**

5. Summary: Directs the Board of Game and Inland Fisheries to develop model bow ordinances for those counties and cities where the deer population is overabundant, resulting in conflicts between humans and deer. The ordinances are to include the times of day in which such hunting can occur and limits on how many deer can be killed. The localities adopting one of the model ordinances may impose a Class 3 misdemeanor on those persons violating the ordinance.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. No fiscal impact.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: Any costs associated with development of regulations and a model ordinance will be absorbed by the agency.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Game and Inland Fisheries; Board of Game and Inland Fisheries.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: Violation of this provision would be a Class 3 misdemeanor. Anyone convicted of a Class 3 misdemeanor is subject to a fine of up to \$500. There is not enough information available to reliably project the amount of revenue that would be collected from fines as a result of this proposal. Any revenue from fines must be deposited into the Literary Fund.
