5. Summary: This bill designates a portion of the Hughes River, approximately 10 miles, as a component of the Virginia Scenic Rivers System.

8. Fiscal Implications: Studies related to this designation have already been completed by the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR), which is tasked with oversight of these designations. The agency anticipates being able to absorb any additional costs resulting from this bill.
