wo ser est poj \$8. fur on Co	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> There is no fiscal impact to SBE; however, violation of this provision ould be a Class 1 misdemeanor. Anyone convicted of a Class 1 misdemeanor is subject to a natence of up to 12 months in jail. There is not enough information available to reliably timate how many additional inmates in jail could result from this proposal. Any increase in jail pulation will increase costs to the state. The Commonwealth presently pays the localities .00 a day for each misdemeanant or otherwise local responsible prisoner held in a jail. It also not not of the jails' operating costs, e.g. correctional officers. The state's share of these costs a per prisoner, per day basis varies from locality to locality. However, according to the ompensation Board's most recent Jail Cost Report (November 2009), the estimated total state pport for local jails averaged \$32.66 per inmate, per day in FY 2008.
