wo sen esti por \$8. fun on Co	Fiscal Implications: There is no fiscal impact to SBE; however, violation of this provision ruld be a Class 1 misdemeanor. Anyone convicted of a Class 1 misdemeanor is subject to a stence of up to 12 months in jail. There is not enough information available to reliably imate how many additional inmates in jail could result from this proposal. Any increase in jail roulation will increase costs to the state. The Commonwealth presently pays the localities 00 a day for each misdemeanant or otherwise local responsible prisoner held in a jail. It also add most of the jails' operating costs, e.g. correctional officers. The state's share of these costs a per prisoner, per day basis varies from locality to locality. However, according to the impensation Board's most recent Jail Cost Report (November 2009), the estimated total state oper for local jails averaged \$32.66 per inmate, per day in FY 2008.
