3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Home service contract providers.

5. Summary: Exempt home service contract providers with a net worth in excess of \$100 million from the licensing requirements under Article 2 of Chapter 26 of Title 38.2. Amends the definition of provider to include home service contract provider. Adds to the list of exemptions from Article 2 any home service contract provider with a net worth in excess of \$100 million. Clarifies that it is the insurer issuing the reimbursement insurance policy that must meet the surplus to policyholder requirements listed in this subdivision, and not the home service contract provider. Additional grammatical changes are made to subsection E.

Other comments: Bureau of Insurance staff worked with interested parties on the provisions contained in House Bill 532 to address an inconsistency between the exemption provisions under Article 1 of Chapter 26 (§ 38.2-2601 2 (ii)) and Article 2 of Chapter 26 (§ 38.2-2618), as well as technical corrections to §§ 38.2-2617 and 38.2-2619.

House Bill 532 is identical to Senate Bill 439.
