Other comments: Federal law provides that an employer may request a health assessment as a condition for enrollment in a wellness program provided the program meets certain additional requirements. House Bill 548 does not conflict with federal law or Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act nondiscrimination provisions, as the bill would not prevent compliance with federal standards. With passage of House Bill 548, insurers would be required to file premium discounts provided for wellness programs established in a group health plan with the Bureau of Insurance.
