Allows HMOs to evide health care plans that do not include all of the mandated benefits. Adds "evidence of verage" to the policy forms and subscription contracts that must disclose that all state-indated benefits are not included in the coverage. The disclosure must be included in any polication or enrollment form as well as the contract and evidence of coverage. Coverage for immograms, pap smears, PSA testing, and colorectal cancer screening must be included.
