4. Title: Standards of Quality; local school board to include in its annual report

5. Summary: Requires each local school board to include in its annual report to the Board of Education the number of students who passed Virginia's Workplace Readiness Skills assessment and the National Occupational Competency Assessments passed. These assessments are in addition to the current related reporting requirements of the number of industry certifications obtained, state licensure examinations passed, and career and technical education completers who graduated. The bill requires separate reporting categories on the School Performance Report Card.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation would require school boards to report the number of students who passed the Virginia Workplace Readiness Skills assessment and the National Occupational Competency Assessment passed each year, in addition to the current industry certification reporting requirements. To include these additional assessments in the annual reporting requirements, would result in some additional administrative costs for both the Department of Education and local school divisions. However, it is assumed such costs can be absorbed within the current resources.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Board of Education and local school divisions.
