**4. Title:** Public transit services; criminal background checks.

**5. Summary:** Authorizes certain transportation district commissions and their contractors and public service corporations or contractors that provide public transit services to a locality to require fingerprint checks of certain applicants and employees so that an FBI criminal background check can be conducted. It also stipulates that the commissions are to bear all costs of obtaining criminal history record information, including expenses incurred by the State Police.
