Summary: Provides that no contract of insurance upon a debtor paid in advance or by a single premium shall be made or effectuated unless, at the time of the contract, the debtor is provided with a prominent notice disclosing his right to a refund of premium in the event the insurance is terminated prior to its scheduled maturity date or the insured indebtedness is terminated or paid off early and of the obligation of the debtor to provide notification to the insurer under subdivision D 8 of § 38.2-3724.
