**4. Title:**         **License to fish; South Holston Reservoir.**

**5. Summary:** This bill adds an additional license fee for state residents to fish and to harvest trout in the interstate waters of South Holston Reservoir.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final. See item 8.

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill would have no appreciable impact to the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries.

Currently, to fish the South Holston Reservoir, Virginians have to hold both a Virginia fishing license and a Tennessee fishing license. Due to the reciprocal agreement in accordance with § 29.1-535, the additional \$20 on the Virginia residents would not provide any additional revenue because Tennessee residents would no longer be required to purchase a Virginia license to fish the Virginia side. Any gain would be negated by the loss of the former Tennessee license holders.
