4. Title: **Board for Asbestos, Lead, Mold, and Home Inspectors; regulation of home energy auditors.**

5. Summary: This bill provides for the licensure of home energy auditors by the Board for Asbestos, Lead, Mold, and Home Inspectors. The bill defines home energy audits and includes one licensed home energy auditor to be appointed to the Board for Asbestos, Lead, Mold, and Home Inspectors, and changes the name of the Board to Board for Asbestos, Lead, Mold, Home Inspectors, and Home Energy Auditors.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate. See item 8.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: At this time, there is not enough information to determine what the approximate costs would be from the implementation of the new license on home energy auditors. The Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation will absorb any related administrative costs at this time.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: The Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: The second enactment clause states that the Board for Asbestos, Lead, Mold, Home Inspectors, and Home Energy Auditors shall promulgate regulations to implement the provisions of this act to be effective within 280 days of its enactment.
