**3. Committee:** Passed Both Houses

**4. Title:** Punishment for delinquent acts.

**5. Summary:** Provides that if a juvenile commits a second or subsequent offense of underage possession of alcohol, public intoxication, or possession of a handgun or streetsweeper shotgun, his case shall not be simply dismissed upon completion of terms and conditions, as is currently an option, but shall be disposed of according to § 16.2-278.8 (multiple options, including commitment to the Department of Juvenile Justice).

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of Juvenile Justice, the proposed legislation is not likely to have a fiscal impact. The agency stated that a juvenile being denied a license will not have an impact on the agency and that the second offense portion of the legislation would not impact the agency since only juveniles with a felony or four distinct misdemeanors would be committed to the department per §16.1-278.8.14 of the Code of Virginia.
