4. Title: Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; charitable gaming; revocation of permits.

Summary: This bill limits the authority of the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services to revoke, suspend, or deny a permit to conduct charitable gaming by requiring the Department to make a written finding that any noncompliance with charitable gaming laws or the Charitable Gaming Board's regulations constitutes a substantial and immediate threat to the public health, safety, or welfare.
