**4. Title:** **Restricted learner's permit**

**5. Summary:** This bill authorizes the Department of Motor Vehicles to issue a restricted learner's permit if the person is 19 years of age or older and a court has authorized or issued a restricted license to the person.

**6. Fiscal impact estimates:** Preliminary. See Item #8.

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal implications:** This bill would have minimal fiscal impact on the operations of the Department of Motor Vehicles. The automated system cost required to implement the legislation is estimated at \$16,830 and includes vendor costs to change the Learner's Permit credential in order to accept restriction codes.

**9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** Department of Motor Vehicles.
