- 5. Summary: Natural gas utilities; cost recovery for certain infrastructure improvement costs. Authorizes investor-owned natural gas utilities to petition the State Corporation Commission to implement a separate rider that will allow for recovery of certain costs associated with eligible infrastructure replacement projects. Eligible infrastructure replacement projects are projects that: (i) enhance safety or reliability by reducing system integrity risks associated with customer outages, corrosion, equipment failures, material failures, natural forces or other outside force damage; (ii) do not increase revenues by directly connecting the infrastructure replacement to new customers; (iii) reduce or have the potential to reduce greenhouse gas emissions; (iv) are commenced on or after January 1, 2010; and (v) are not included in the natural gas utility's rate base in its most recent rate case. The costs recoverable from an eligible infrastructure replacement project include a return on the investment, depreciation, property taxes, and carrying costs on the over- or under- recovery of the eligible infrastructure replacement costs. A SAVE plan shall be allocated and charged so as to avoid undue cross-subsidization between rate classes.

- **8. Fiscal Implications:** The fiscal impact may vary, depending on the magnitude of the SAVE Rider and gas usage. There could be a possible rate impact on state agencies that take service under regulated natural gas utilities' retail rates that may include a SAVE Rider.

- **11. Other Comments:** Senate Bill 112 appears to be identical to House Bill 533.
