**4. Title:** Detention of transferred or certified juveniles.

**5. Summary:** Provides that juveniles whose criminal cases have been transferred to circuit court or certified be placed in a juvenile secure facility rather than in adult correctional facilities. If the juvenile demonstrates that he is a threat to the security or safety of the other juveniles detained or the staff of the home or facility, he may be moved to an adult facility if authorized by the court.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Juvenile Justice does not expect a fiscal impact due to the proposed legislation. It is not known if local detention facilities would have a fiscal impact.
