Fiscal Implications: This legislation makes minor changes to §§ 22.1-361 and 22.1-360 of the Code of Virginia regarding the Virginia Council on the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children, established pursuant to Chapter 187 of the 2009 Acts of Assembly. DOE currently receives \$200,000 each year to cover expenses for the council. The changes proposed in this bill are not expected to result in additional costs, as such, no fiscal impact is anticipated.
