**4. Title:** Voter registration exchange; pilot program

**5. Summary:** Directs the State Board of Elections to conduct a pilot program with at least three other states by July 1, 2011, to determine the number of duplicate registrations and to report in September 2011, to the Committees on Privileges and Elections, on the number of duplicate registrations discovered and the steps taken by the Board to eliminate duplicate registrations.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Indeterminate fiscal impact

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The enactment of this bill would require SBE to use existing authority to match voter list with other states. To do this will require technology resources as well as the need to create new matching algorithms. Necessary changes to the Virginia Election and Registration Information System (VERIS) will also result in increased costs.
