4. Title: Information provided to political parties and candidates.

5. Summary: Provides that, upon request and at a reasonable price, a political party or candidate is entitled to receive a copy of (i) the list of officers of election, (ii) the list of absentee voter applicants, and (iii) any rules or regulations made by the State Board of Elections or any instructions or information provided by the State Board to local electoral boards and registrars. This substitute also requires the Board to post any rules or regulations to the Internet within three business days.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: There is no net fiscal impact to State Board of Elections (SBE)

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill allows SBE to provide data/information at a reasonable price which allows the agency to recoup costs, therefore resulting in a zero net fiscal impact.
