3. Committee: Passed both houses.

4. Title: Water safety zones.

5. Summary: This bill authorizes marine patrol divisions of police departments in Tidewater localities and conservation police officers of the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries to patrol those tidal waters that have been designated as federal safety zones and federal restricted areas.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See item 8.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill is not expected to have a fiscal impact on the Marine Resources Commission or the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. The agencies will absorb any related costs associated with this bill.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Marine Resources Commission; Department of Game and Inland Fisheries.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: The second enactment clause repeals the second enactment of Chapter 554 of the Acts of Assembly of 2007 (provides that the Virginia Beach Police Department Marine Patrol is authorized to patrol and enforce federal zones).
