4. Title: HOV lanes; clean special fuel vehicles; government use

5. Summary: This bill removes the requirement that the Commissioner provide written regulations before the Department of Motor Vehicles may issue government-use license plates for clean special fuel vehicles.

6. No fiscal impact. Final.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: Any loss of revenue resulting from a lower fee for government-use vehicles is unable to be estimated, though the amount is anticipated to be minimal.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Department of Motor Vehicles, Northern Virginia and Tidewater localities where vehicles with clean special fuel plates are granted HOV lane-use exemptions, other state agencies and localities that desire to obtain government-use clean special fuel license plates.

10. Technical amendment necessary: No.

11. Other comments: The substitute bill adds electrolytic oxy-hydrogen injection as well as a combination of oxy-hydrogen and gasoline or diesel to those products defined as clean special fuels.
