4. Title: **Individual health insurance coverage; requirement to obtain.**

5. Summary: Provides that a resident of Virginia cannot be required to obtain or maintain an individual insurance policy. The provision applies whether or not the person, has or is eligible for, health insurance coverage through his employer, the Commonwealth of Virginia, or the federal government. The bill also provides that no provision of the Insurance Title can render a Virginia resident liable for any penalty, assessment, fee, or fine because of a failure to procure or obtain health insurance coverage.
