4. Title: Disabled parking; windshield placard shall not show certain personal information

- **5. Summary:** This bill provides that permanent and removable windshield placards shall not show the name, age, and sex of the person to whom issued.
- 6. Fiscal impact estimates: Final. See Item #8 below.
- 7. Budget amendment necessary: No.
- **8.** Fiscal implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles would incur costs in the implementation of this legislation. The disabled parking placards would need to be redesigned by the vendor to remove the name, age, and sex of the person who has been issued the placard. This one-time cost is estimated at \$2,500.

In addition, pursuant to the first enactment clause, existing placard holders could request a replacement placard with the new design. Currently, there are a total of 418,768 active permanent and temporary removable disabled parking windshield placards. Although the number of placard holders who would request a replacement is unknown, the agency could incur a cost in replacing even a portion of these placards.
