3. Committee: Passed Both Houses.

4. Title: Juvenile records; gang information; exceptions to confidentiality.

5. Summary: Places an affirmative duty on the Department of Juvenile Justice to provide information to law-enforcement that may aid in initiating or furthering an investigation of a criminal street gang. The bill also requires, rather than allows, the Department or locally operated court services unit to release to law enforcement information on a juvenile's criminal street gang involvement and the criminal street gang-related activity of others.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Juvenile Justice, the proposal should have no fiscal impact on the agency.
