- 4. Title:** Training center; physician
- 5. Summary:** The substitute bill requires the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services to require the presence of a licensed physician at all times in any state training center with licensed skilled nursing facility beds.
- 6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** No fiscal impact
- 7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No
- 8. Fiscal Implications:** The substitute bill would require a licensed physician to be on site, 24/7 at any training center with skilled nursing beds. Currently, only Central Virginia Training Center has skilled nursing facility beds. Licensed physician coverage is already a requirement at CVTC, therefore the bill would have no fiscal impact on the agency.
